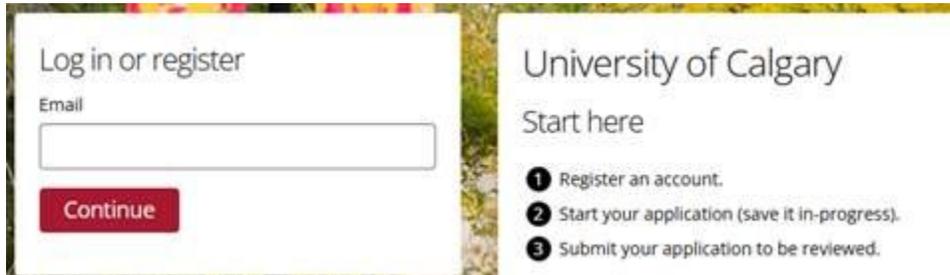


## Instructions for Applicants – Application form

**Step 1:** To access the application form, click [universityofcalgary.grantplatform.com](https://universityofcalgary.grantplatform.com).

**Step 2:** Navigate to the general page, scroll down to the captured section and enter your email:



**Step 3:** After entering your email, you'll be directed to a page where you need to enter the security verification code sent to your inbox.

### 2-factor authentication

Remember for 30 days

Enter the code shown by your Authentication app, one of your unused backup codes, or the backup code sent to your phone.

If the 6-digit code is not working or you took too much time to enter it, please click on "Resend code." If the issue persists, please contact Good Grants directly at [help@goodgrants.com](mailto:help@goodgrants.com). The Good Grants team typically responds within three hours.

**Step 4:** You will have to set up a multi-factor authenticator. You can use one of these applications:

- Microsoft Authenticator **\*Recommended option\*** used by the University of Calgary. If you select that option, you can open the app and scan the QR code directly from it.
- Google Authenticator
- Okta

- OneLogin Support

**If you have issues with the multi-factor authenticator (MFA):**

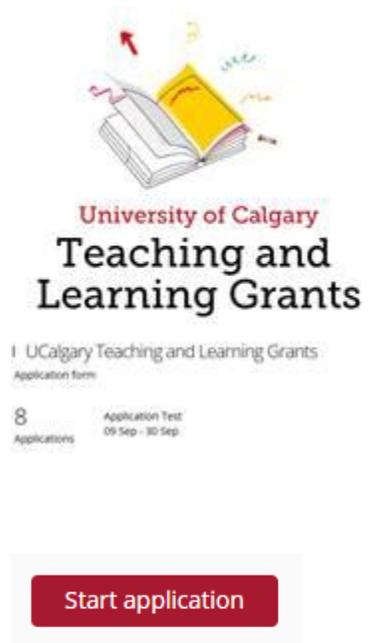
There are many MFA tools available, each slightly different, but all prone to the same types of issues. Including lost backup codes, syncing problems, authenticator app glitches, or even network connection snags.

### Setting up Multifactor Authentication – Microsoft Authenticator

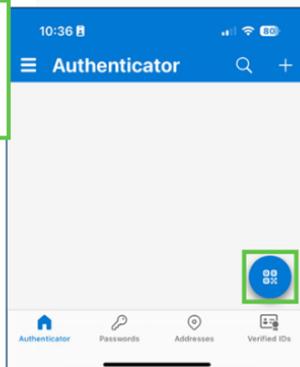
