What is the USRI & what is changing?


- Universal Student Ratings of Instruction (USRI) is a method of gathering quantitative course feedback from students.
- As of early 2023, the platform for reporting has changed from a Cognos (IBM) platform to a PowerBI (Microsoft) platform.
 - This change bring changes in navigation to see reports.



How to see results

Step 1

 Go to <u>www.ucalgary.ca/</u> and Login to your My UCalgary.






How to see results

Step 2

Go to Academic >
 Teaching and then click
 on the "View course
 evaluations" link.





Step 3

 Login with your IT username and password and with 2 factor authentication





How to see results Step 4

Find the row for the course & section # you want, in that row right click on the "Survey Release Indicator" and then go to "Drill Through" and select "Printer PDF Version"








How to see results


- The Printer PDF version gives you the option to navigate through 5 web pages and includes demographic data and an interpretation guide providing context and additional information
- You can export to PDF and save the file to your computer (about 10 pages in total)





How to see results


- You can also see your results for courses prior to Summer 2020 in a historical format that uses Mean (average) instead of Mode (most frequently selected) and includes question 2.1
- In PowerBI, use the navigation options on the left column to select "USRI Instructor Historical Report".





How to see results

- Use the navigation options on the left column to go to Report Info
- This provides information about the report







What else is important about course feedback?

- In order for USRI results to be releasable other than to the instructor, two conditions must both be met:
 - There must be at least 8 students responding
 - The number of responses must be at least 20% of enrolled students
- All USRIs from Winter 2020 to and including Winter 2021 were hardcoded as Not Releasable (regardless of response rate) as per the Provost and in consideration of challenges posed by the Covid-19 pandemic.
 - These reports may only be seen by the instructor they pertain to.
